Dear Teamsters 419,

We are writing to extend our solidarity to you as you fight for a fair contract. PSAC local 901 represents almost 2000 graduate teaching assistants, teaching fellows, and postdoctoral researchers at Queen's University. All of us in Ontario are presently facing the growth of precarious work and seeing the ways in which practices such as outsourcing and contract-flipping are undermining the quality of jobs in workplaces across the province. We see this on our university campuses as well. It takes union workers who are willing to say no to precarious work and demand at least \$15 and scheduling fairness in their contracts to oppose this. We salute Teamsters 419 for taking strike action against Swissport.

Swissport is a company that has the means to set a higher standard for decent work in Ontario, rather than waiting for provincial legislation such as Bill 148 to force their hand. We call on Swissport to stop undermining the safety of both workers and customers through the use of temporary labour, and to bargain in good faith with Teamsters 419.
