901 is back at the bargaining table today with the certain and overwhelming support of the membership. 901 has also successful garnered support from AMS (Undergraduate Student Government) and QUFA (Queen's Faculty Association). "We hope that the outpouring of support encourages the employer to take our proposals more seriously moving forward. Conciliation was a first good step but now they really can't ignore the backing we've received from our members in returning a strike mandate."
