Call for Nominations: Co-Lead Steward (1 position)

The LBO is calling for nominations for the position of Co-Lead Steward.

PSAC Local 901 has 3 Co-Lead Stewards (1 vacant position) who work together as Grievance Officers for the union. The full duties of the Co-Lead Stewards are outlined in section 5.1.7 of PSAC Local 901's Bylaws. The position of Co-Lead Steward will be elected at the Special General Meeting (SGM) on Monday, August 10, 2026.

Nomination letters must contain the following information:

- name;
- Department;
- employment position;
- a brief statement (no more than five-hundred (500) words) about the candidate's previous Union experience.

Nominations will only be accepted via email until Monday, August 3. All nominations received by this deadline will be included in the agenda and emailed to members prior to the SGM. If you miss this deadline and want to self-nominate, you are welcome to nominate yourself from the floor at the SGM. If you choose to self-nominate from the floor at the SGM, candidates should be prepared to address the above.

At the SGM, all candidates (including those nominated from the floor) will be asked to come to the front of the room and will be given one minute to speak. After all candidates have spoken, there will be a five-minute question period.

Co-lead Stewards are members of PSAC Local 901's Executive Committee and receive an honorarium of \$750/month. Serving as Co-Lead Steward is an opportunity to work as part of a team to support, represent, and advocate for our union members.
